**Global Health Partner plc (“GHP” or the “Company”)
Acquisition of Obesity Stockholm AB (“OS”)**

GHP announces that it has today completed the acquisition of 65% of OS, the owner of a private surgery clinic currently operating at Sophiahemmet hospital in Stockholm. OS, through its 100% owned subsidiary, Kirurgkliniken Sverige AB, operates the third largest obesity clinic in Sweden and the largest private clinic in Sweden by number of procedures.

Acquisition details

GHP has acquired 65% of the shares of OS through its subsidiary GHP Obesity Holding AB in return for the allotment of 328,829 new ordinary shares of 50 pence in GHP Plc (“Consideration Shares”). Goran Lundegardh, the vendor of the clinic, will retain a 35% interest in OS. In the latest 12 months financial statements to June 30, 2006 OS had revenues of approximately £993,000 and an adjusted profit after tax of approximately £146,000 on its accounting basis, translated at current rates of exchange (SEK/£:13.7). Pro Forma gross assets were approximately £219,000.

The Board of GHP has obtained an independent valuation of OS under s103(1) Companies Act 1985 that the consideration received by GHP Obesity Holding AB in return for the issue of GHP ordinary shares is fair.

The Consideration Shares, which will rank pari passu with all existing ordinary shares, are subject to a lock up until February 15, 2008.

Application has been made for the Consideration Shares to be admitted to trading on AIM. This is expected to occur on or about Tuesday, February 20, 2007.

OS

OS is the recently formed holding company for Kirurgkliniken Sverige AB, which is the third largest obesity clinic in Sweden and the largest private clinic in Sweden by number of procedures. The clinic operates on a private basis and has a contract with Stockholm County. Its owner Goran Lundegardh is an experienced obesity surgeon who has been performing gastric by-pass and laparoscopic by-pass surgery with nursing and dietician support at Sophiahemmet Hospital in Stockholm for the last seven years.

Development of Obesity Service Line within GHP

GHP announced in September 2006 its intention to make obesity treatment its fourth service line by entering into a ten year development agreement with Sahlgrenska University Hospital to design a model for optimal specialist treatment of morbid obesity. GHP is very pleased now to announce this first acquisition of a leading Swedish obesity clinic, which is intended to operate in line with this developed model. The model itself is on track to be delivered during spring 2007.

It is intended that Goran Lundegardh will take a leading role in the development of the GHP Obesity Service Line. It is planned during 2007 to expand its operations at SSV. SSV, acquired in January 2007, is GHP's orthopaedic clinic at Lowenstromska sjukhuset in Stockholm, which retains operating facilities suitable for obesity surgery.

Commenting on the proposed acquisition, Per Batelson, Chairman and Chief Executive of GHP, said:

"The acquisition of this specialist obesity clinic with its strong reputation for clinical excellence and well established operating position in obesity surgery in the Swedish market is both a logical and significant step forward for GHP in the development of our important obesity service line. We will look to exploit the potential development opportunities in expanding its operations also to SSV."
